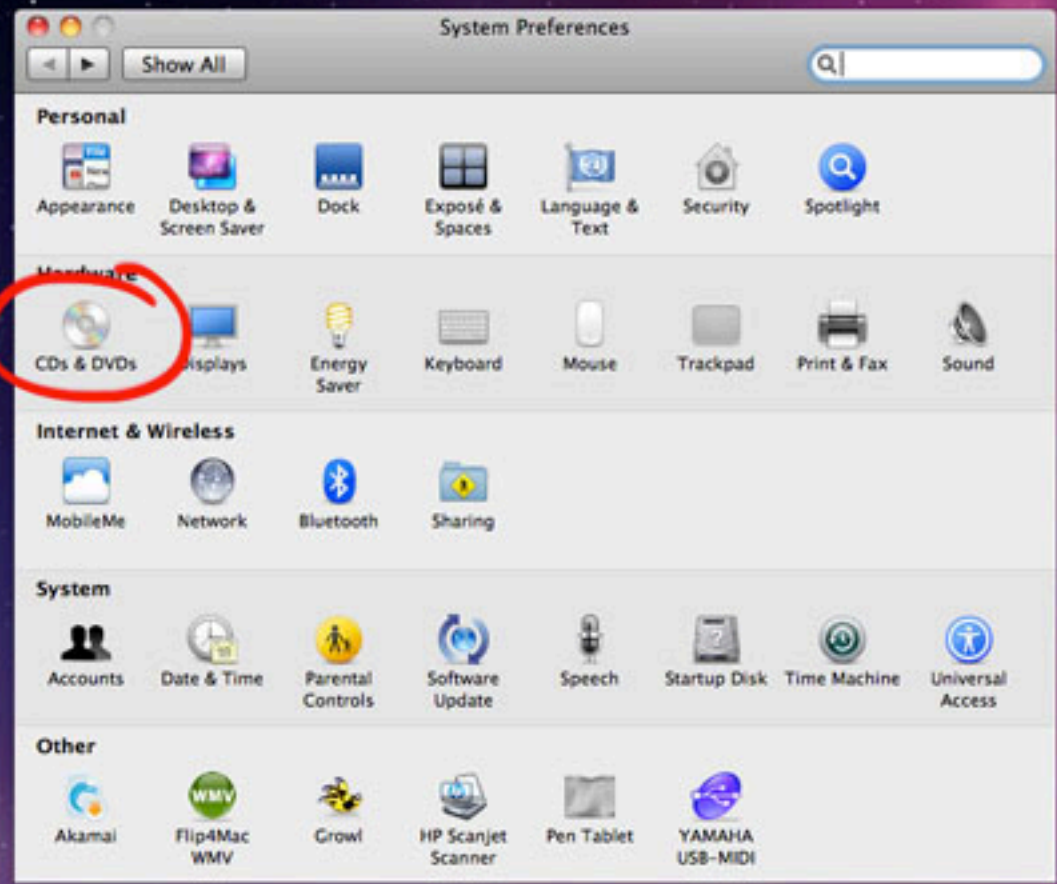
This guide shows you how you can solve an issue where the Practice DVD crashes your Mac. This is a software issue that can be easily fixed in 2 steps and takes a couple of minutes. This problem only occurs on Macs and the DVD will run fine on TV DVD players and PCs. It is the result of a conflict when Mac's DVD Player plays region free DVDs.

Step 1

Change your autorun settings so that in future the DVD player does not start up automatically as soon as you put the Practice DVD into your machine.

Go to the Apple icon and select System Preferences.

Find the CDs & DVDs options icon.

Double-click to open the CD & DVDs options page.

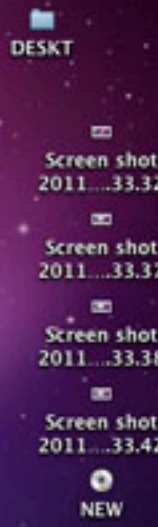

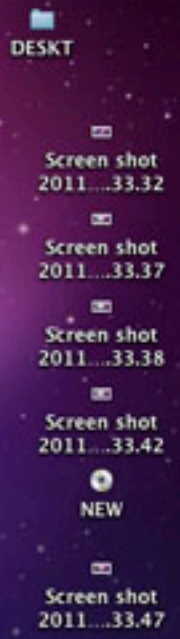
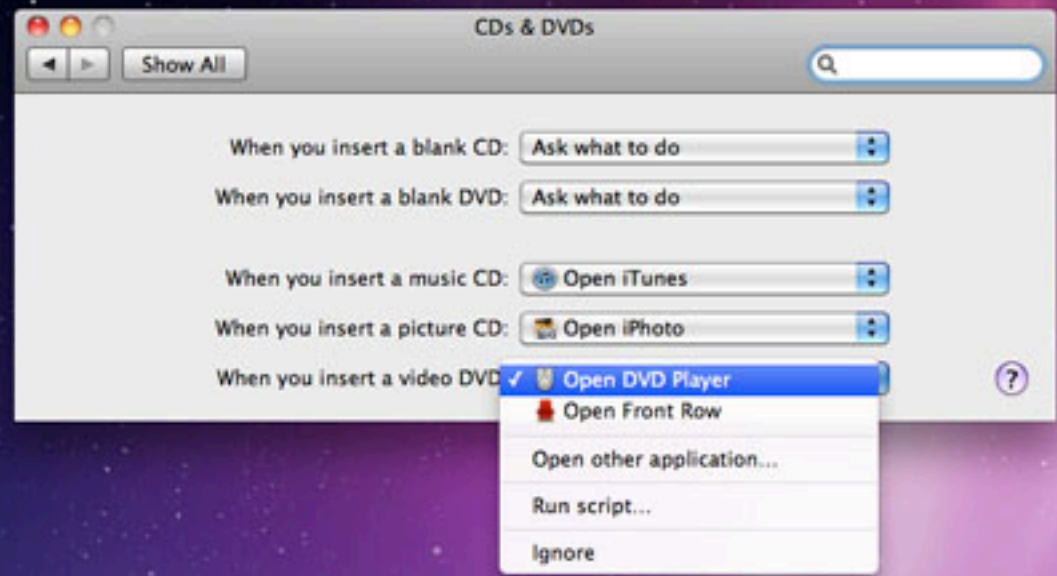

You will notice that by default it will be set to Open DVD Player whenever you insert a DVD into your DVD drive.





In the drop down menu you can choose a number of options to tell your computer what to do. In this case we're going to choose ignore. This means that nothing will happen when you insert a DVD into your drive. Don't worry because we'll show you how to open the DVD with VLC media player.
